## Sergey Maximishin

The Russian photojournalist makes his
New York début with recent color work
from Siberia, balancing harsh scenes
(landscapes of snowbound housing blocks, a
fire-ravaged forest) with more intimate
views (a couple cuddling on the train, two
men in a bunk gazing at a celebrity
magazine). Maximishin gives us an insider's
view, in images that are subtle and
unexpected. In one picture, a mural of giant
flowers and butterflies provides the
backdrop for people walking single file
through knee-deep snow. In another, a
silver-painted statue of Lenin glints in the
afternoon sun. Through Jan. 18.
